



The route to Galilee





- 4:29 The Christ, because of his words

For:

Fits the context well (8:12)

Christ and Scribes and Pharisees in character

Apostle John's disciples knew of it


Augustine says some removed it from their manuscripts to stop women appealing to this tale

- Jesus will not condemn





 Learned to undertake her service in quiet patience...and others helped her (John 12:1)






Women in Luke






Healing by touch


