

6:39	This is the <u>Will</u> of the One who sent me	=	Losing nothing of all those God gave Jesus
6:40	This is the <u>Will</u> of my Father	=	Giving eternal life to everyone beholding the Son and believing in him
15:12	This is my Commandment	=	Loving one another
1 Jn. 5:3	This is the Love of God	=	Keeping his commandments
17:3	This is <u>Eternal Life</u>	=	Knowing God & His Son

He who hears My word and believes in Him who sent Me has everlasting life, and shall not come into judgment, but has passed from the death into the life.








This is The Life I wish to give my disciples: a Life, a way of living, that will allow them to get to know you and me fully, a way of living that will never end.
