Our Life's Journey

Leaving - Journey in Between - Destination

He has shown you, O man, what is good; And what does the Lord require of you but to do justly, to love mercy, and to humble yourself to walk with your God? Mic. 6:8 (lit. trans.)

Humble Yourself to Walk with God Deut. 8:1-5

All our experiences are known by God beforehand!

Heb. 3:12-14

Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time, casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you. 1 Pet. 5:6-7

God walking with us! Deut. 2:7

Exod. 2:23-25 Psa. 317 Isa. 63:7-9

Yet I am the Lord your God ever since the land of Egypt, and you shall know no God but Me; For there is no savior besides Me. I knew you in the wilderness, in the land of great drought.

Hos. 13:4-5

Walking with God? Sons of Eli: 1 Sam. 2:12-17

Now sons of Eli were base men; they knew not the LORD... And sin of the young men was very great before the LORD; for the men despised the offering of the LORD.

Walking with God? Northern Kingdom: Hosea

"My God, we know You!" (8:2)

"I will cause all her mirth to cease, her <u>feast days</u>, her <u>New Moons</u>, her <u>Sabbaths</u>—all her appointed feasts." (2:1 1)

For I desire mercy and not sacrifice, and the knowledge of God more than burnt offerings. (6:6)

Mercy = God's covenant love expressed in His desire to forgive, heal, and redeem His People from all their troubles.

Knowing God = Knowing God's heart and sharing His concerns!

Walking with God? Northern Kingdom: Hosea

Instead of "mercy" & concern for God—swearing, lying, killing, stealing, adultery, bloodshed. (4:1-2)

"My people ask counsel from their wooden idols...they have played the harlot against their God. They offer sacrifices on the mountaintops, and burn incense on the hills." (4:11-13)

"Let him who glories glory in this, that he <u>understands and</u> <u>knows me</u>, that I am the LORD, exercising <u>mercy</u>, <u>justice</u> and <u>righteousness</u> in the earth. For in these things I delight, says the LORD." (Jer. 9:24)

Walking with God 1 Jn. 1

The Life was manifested and we have seen, and bear witness, and declare to you that Eternal Life which was with the Father and was manifested to us. (v.2-3)

God is light and in Him is no darkness at all. (v.5)

If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another... (v.6-7)

Walking with God

God comes to know us, when He walks with us.

We come to know God, when we walk with Him.

Walking with God Jn. 17:20-21

I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word; that they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me.

My Father (is) in me = Jesus knew what was in the heart of his Father because he experienced what his Father did.

I (am) in my Father = God knew what was in the heart of His Son because He experienced what His Son did.

Walking with God Jn. 17:23
