Jesus was about to enter his work as High Priest


Our Resurrected Lord Heb. 7:11-19

New Priesthood: "You are a priest forever, after the order of Melchizedek" (v. 17)


New Basis: "an endless (indestructible) life" (v. 16)

Permanent: "an unchangeable priesthood" (v. 24)

Better: "a former commandment is set aside because of its weakness and uselessness...(but) a better hope is introduced, through which we draw near to God." (v.19)
